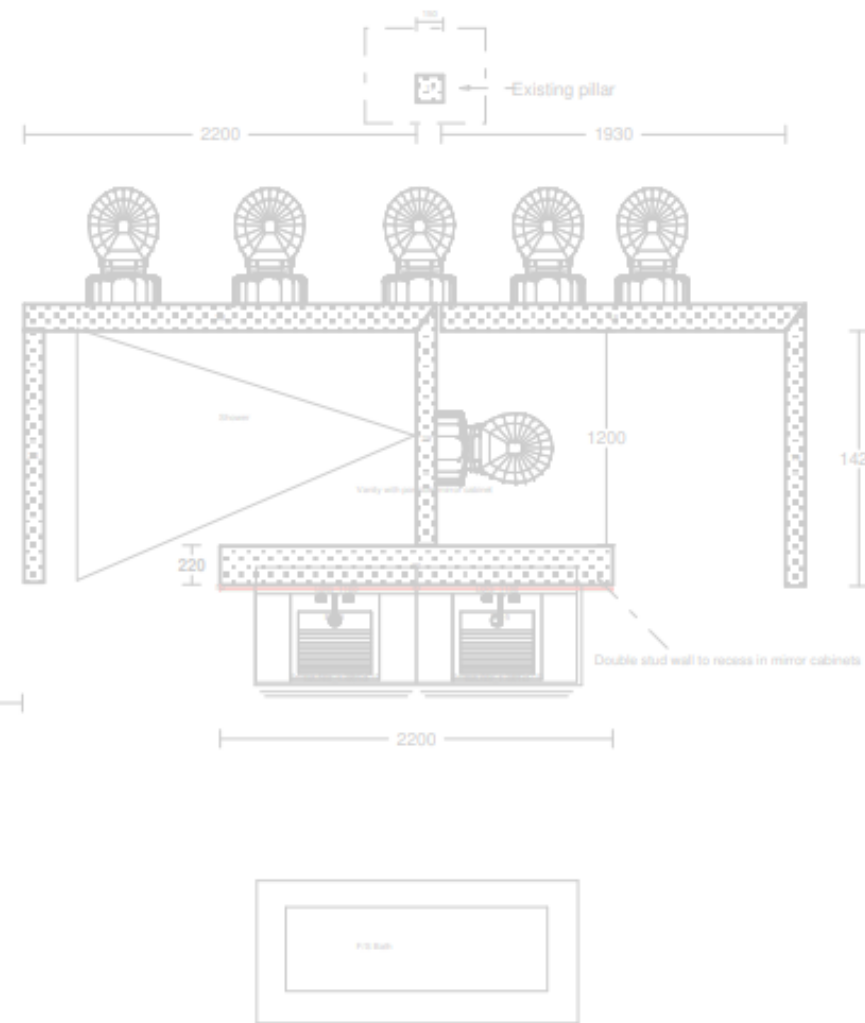
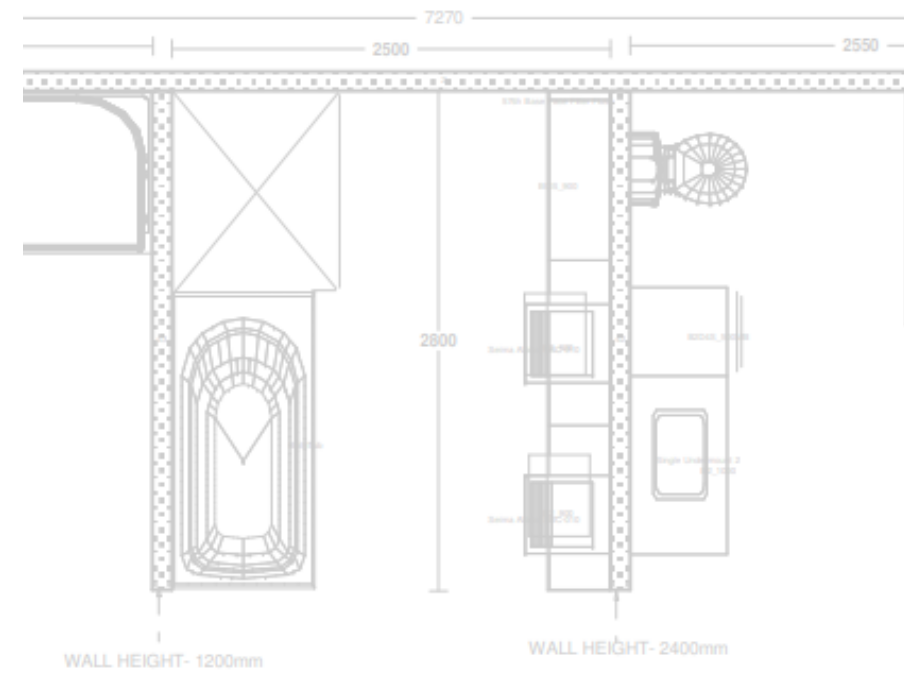
Gallerie Studio cont.....

Appointed as the Gallerie Manager my Initial role with the company was to project manage the conversion of the 1000m² warehouse space from shell to completion.

The space was carefully planned out to take the clients on a journey from the externals to the internal selections of their new or renovated home.

Starting from the bricks, cladding, right through to flooring, sanitary ware, kitchens and finally paints, cornicing and blinds.

The project was completed in 6 months.

A single colour scheme was used for all 3 houses.

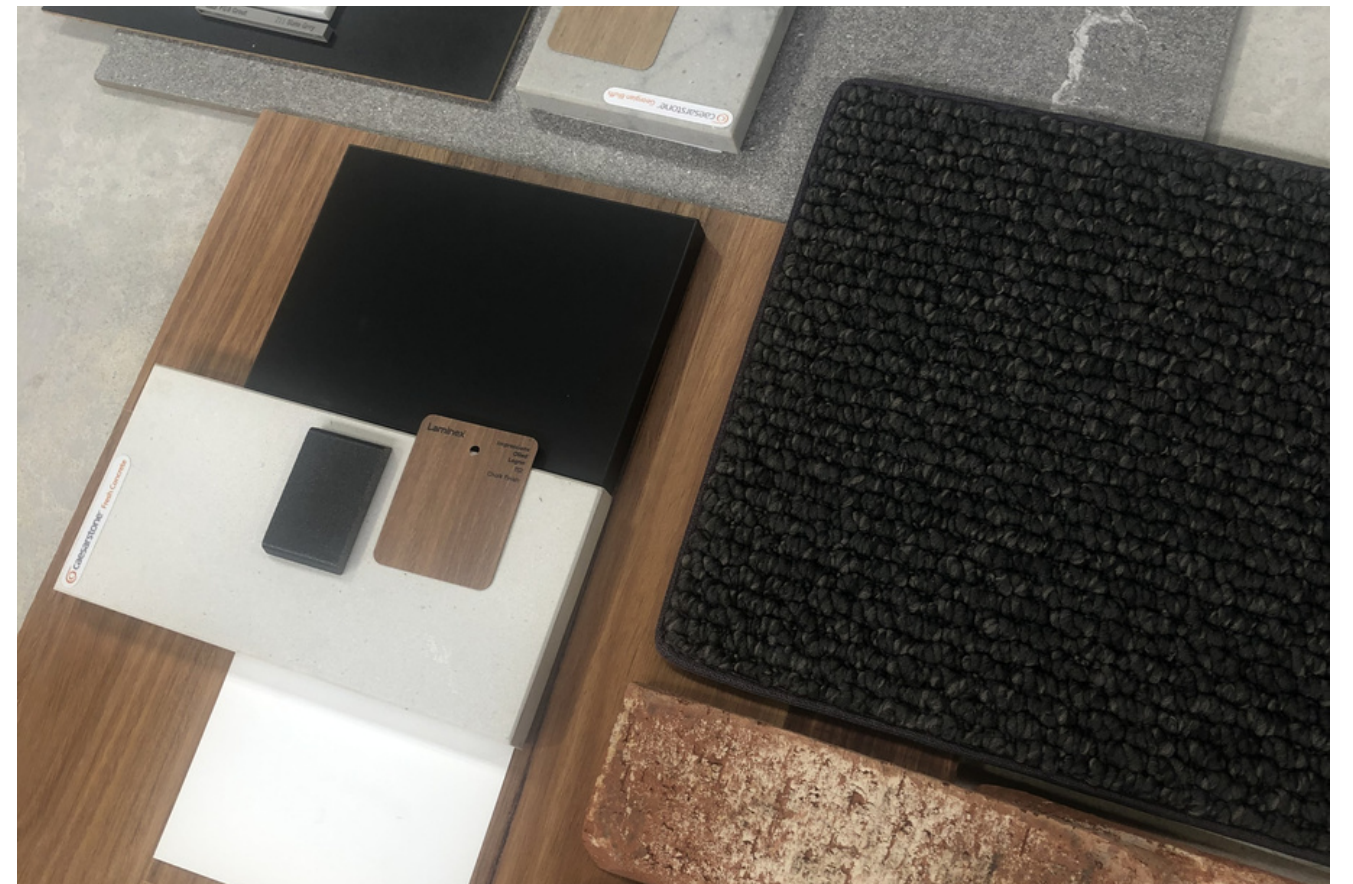
